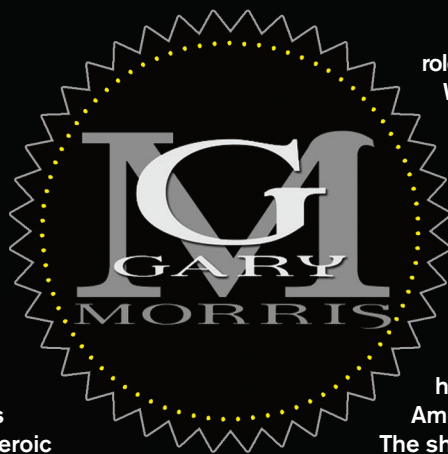


Morris is a prolific songwriter, but is best known for his recording of "Wind Beneath My Wings," which went to number one and won song of the year from both the Country Music Association (CMA) and the Academy of Country Music (ACM). The song was later recorded by Bette Midler, who took the song to the top of the Pop charts.

Notable theater producer, Sir Cameron Macintosh respected Gary's extraordinary vocal range and was in dire need of a performer who could not only successfully execute the lead role in his production of Les Miserables. In keeping with the role of the heroic character, Gary Morris returned to Broadway as the first American actor/singer to perform the lead role of Jean Valjean in the World-renowned Les Miserables at the height of its popularity, receiving resounding critical praise, including a Drama Desk Best Actor nomination and a Command Performance for Queen Elizabeth.

Gary Morris is equally comfortable on stage or in front of the camera as he is in nature, far away from it all. Besides his recurring acting



roles in General Hospital, The Colbys, Designing Women and Mike Hammer to name a few, he has been called upon to sing the title movie soundtracks including "Blind Date," starring Bruce Willis and Kim Basinger as well as the title cut for NBC's daytime soap opera "Another World." Many of his songs have been placed in tv series such as the legendary television drama "Dallas."

The multi-talented artist has also hosted multiple network shows including his own weekly TNN program, "The North American Sportsman," which ran for five years. The show highlighted his love for the great outdoors, and featured such celebrity guests as Bryant Gumble, Troy Aikman and Larry Conk among others. Morris is an elite, skilled bowhunter who has traveled North America hunting and taking every big game animal across the continent.

After a self-imposed intermission on his "Mountain Spirit" ranch in Colorado, Gary Morris is currently recording and preparing to launch a new tour.
